

Typewriter

The typewriter on the Type 705 can be used to print directly from memory, one character at a time. The speed of typing is approximately 600 characters per minute. All other operations of the machine are held up during the typing operation. The typewriter has a 12" carriage and is equipped with a pin feed platen. Maximum length of writing line is $8 \frac{7}{8}$ ", overall form width $9 \frac{7}{8}$ ", and hole-to-hole dimension is $9 \frac{3}{8}$ ". Any character not on the code chart prints as a question mark. A plus zero and a minus zero print as a plus sign and a hyphen respectively. Sensing the record mark automatically causes a carriage return and automatic spacing in accordance with the setting of the space control on the carriage.
